

FIRE ALARM PLAN REVIEW (seminar content)

This application course describes the common problems associated with the plan review process and offers suggestions for improvement by providing plan review and acceptance test checklists, spreadsheets to determine battery and voltage drop calculations, exercises to determine proper spacing of smoke detectors, exercises to determine proper audibility of fire alarm notification appliances and proper sizing and placement of visible notification appliances. This seminar was developed and is based on NFPA 72-2016, 2012 California Building Code (CBC) and the California Fire Code (CFC).
